Dr. Zakir Hussain, a renowned educationist, especially in the field of Basic Education as visualized by Mahatma Gandhi, Father of the Nation, a great humanist, a distinguished exponent of composite culture and a real secularist, who ultimately adorned the coveted chair of the President of India, has been the real moving spirit for the guidance of the management of Dr. Zakir Hussain Teachers' Training College, Darbhanga. His academic philosophy has always helped us in moulding this institution. The Training College will perpetually serve as a tribute to the great departed soul, whose name will constantly inspire us and shine in the annual of Indian History.

Darbhanga is the administrative headquarters of the revenue division, and is situated at a distance of 120 km. by road from Patna, the capital of Bihar towards the North-East. It is also the headquarters of the two well reputed Universities of Bihar i.e., Lalit Narayan Mithila University and Kameshwar bingh Darbhanga Sanskrit University, Darbhanga. Moreover, Darbhanga is the heart-land of Mithilanchal-acultural centre known for its art, paintings and music, and above all for its scholastic and rich tradition of highly philosophic approach to life. Dr. Zakir Hussain Teachers' Training College is 3kms away from Darbhanga Junction and is quite adjacent to Darbhanga Medical College, one of the oldest Medical Colleges of the country.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Under Art 30 (1) of the constitution of India, and Art. (4) of the constitution of the Board of Trustees, Shafi Muslim High School, Laheriasarai (Estd. 1931), a body duly registered with the Govt. of Bihar under Societies Registration Act 1860, the Board resolved to sponsor a Teachers' Training College dated 02.06.1982, to cater to the need of Teachers' Training from the session 1982-83, an imperative need of the large number of untrained graduates of the region and to make them qualified to seek employment as well as to provide opportunity in securing post-graduate degree in Iducation and Research facilities with the passage of time.

Apart from this basic need of the untrained graduates and certificate holders, the Board also felt the necessity of sponsoring a Teachers' Training college in this region which could produce human resources, which could be safely entrusted with the responsibility of teaching the students in Muslim Minority Institutions in anatmosphere conducive to the healthy growth of character of the students in the light of the cultural, religious and linguistic heritage of the community so that they may be able to discharge their national obligation with the imbued quality of heart, head and character, making secular India richer and more glorious.

Trustees recorded its deep appreciation of the decision of the Govt. of Bihar to appoint one Urdu trained Teacher in every school of Bihar to that the goal of linguistic harmony leading to national integration might be achieved. At the same time the Board recorded with deep pains the dearth of Urdu trained teachers for which the posts either lay vacant or were being filled up with the general teachers, having no knowledge of Urdu at all. Hence to fulfil the long-standing necessity of the Muslim Community and of the population of the region, the Board of Trustees sponsored and attablished a Teachers' Training College at Laheriasarai, Darbhanga, Bihar, as a Minority Institution under Art. 30 (1) of the constitution of India with respect to its management.

The Board of Trustees of Shafi Muslim High School, Laheriasarai, Darbhanga (an Educational Foundation) has a reputation of its own either sponsoring or nurturing in its cradle Institution like Shafi Muslim High School, Laheriasarai, Millat College, Darbhanga, H.B. Soghra Hassan Memorial Urdu Girls High School, Darbhanga, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad ITI, Darbhanga, Darbhanga Computer Academy, Darbhanga and other institutions in pursuit of its Educational policies and programme. The Board hasconceived the idea of establishing a Teachers' Training College which is a reality today in the more library and Complex of the Board of Trustees, Shafi Muslim High School, Laheriasarai, Darbhanga.

- present it is really gratifying to note that this college was accorded recognition from 1982-83 session with retrospective effect in 1984.
- This college was also duly recognized by the Eastern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education, Bhubaneswar in 1997 after the enactment of the Central Act under the title NCTE Act. 1995.
- In 1998, the College was duly registered by UGC, New Delhi under 2 (f). Last but not the least, the college was accredited with 'B' grade by NAAC which is a matter of some pride for the entire people of the region as well as the entire fraternity of the college.

Mithila University, Darbhanga has accorded permission to start M.Ed. course in the college from the session 1992-93 vide letter No. 709/92 dated 02.06.1992, & got recognition from the NCTE to run M.Ed. course vide its letter No. ERC/7-87.6 (1).41/2008/11887 dated 04.08.08.
- It is very heartening to know that the Govt. of Bihar has selected Dr. Zakir Hussain Teachers' Training College for Primary Teachers' Training centre vide Letter No. 242 dated 17.12.2003. It is matter of pleasure to note that the N.C.T.E., Bhubaneswar has accorded recognition/ permission to start ETE Course in the college vide letter No. ERC/7-71.5.17/2006 dated 15.12.2006.
- As a matter of fact, this college enjoys a unique position in the fraternity of the University being its first affiliated Teachers' Training College established under Art. 30(1) of the constitution of India and the dream visualized by the guardians of the society has become a reality today. For this we offer our gratitude and thanks to the Almighty and so also acknowledges our gratitude to the ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar and Department of Higher Education, Bihar.

"The Alumni Association" of the college consists of all former students of the college who have enrolled themselves as annual member/life member by paying a subscription.




LIBRARY OF THE COLLEGE

MAGAZINE



ADMISSION PROCEDURE:-

Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of Written Test

DURATION: The D.El.Ed., B.Ed. & M. Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic years, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme.



ELIGIBILITY for D.El.Ed.

- a) Candidates with at least 50% marks in the higher secondary (+2) or its equivalent examination are eligible for admission.
- Marks relaxation 5% for SC/ST candidates.
- c) 5 year age relaxation for SC/ST candidates, 2 year for BC/OBC and 3 year for women Candidates.

AGE 1 Minimum 17 years and Maximum 34 years.

ELIGIBILITY for B.Ed.

candidates with at least fifty percent marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and /or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/ Humanity, Hachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.

FLIGIBILITY for M.Ed.

Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade in the following programme: 01. B.Ed. 02. B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed. 03. B.El.Ed. 04. D.El.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each).

HOW TO APPLY

- a) Application for admission intoD.El.Ed.,B.Ed. & M.Ed. Should be made on the prescribed form which can be obtained from the college office on payment of prescribed fees.
- b) Application received after the closing date or incomplete in any respect will be rejected.

ENCLOSURE WITH THE APPLICATION:

- a) Attested Photostat copy of the certificate of matriculation or S.S. Examination showing the date of birth of the candidate.
- b) Attested Photostat copy of all mark sheets.
- c) Attested Photostat copy of S.L.C./ C.L.C./ D.L.C.
- d) Attested Photostat copy of other activities, accomplishment, if any.
- e) Attested Photostat copy of Aadhar Card.

REQUIREMENT

- a) Original S.L.C./ C.L.C./ D.L.C. and other original certificates and degree are to be produced at the time of admission for verification/ submission.
- b) Five copies of recent passport-size colour photograph of the candidate.
- c) Admission charges as prescribed in the prospectus.

FEE STRUCTURE (D.El.Ed., B.Ed. & M.Ed. Course)

At the time of admission to the D.El.Ed., B. Ed. & M.Ed. selected candidates are required to pay



OTHER INFORMATION

- Admission into D.El.Ed. /B.Ed. /M.Ed. of any candidate is provisional and may be cancelled if any discrepancy is detected in the paper/ document submitted or the candidate fails to comply with the rules, regulations and other conditions laid down by the college in the Bye-laws as well as prospectus of the college.
- Admission even after confirmation may be cancelled in case the candidate fails show satisfactory progress in studies as well as on the ground of misconduct in and out of the college.
- In case a candidate fails to submit his/her required documents at the time of admission along with required fees, he will forfeit his/her claim for admission to the concerned course and seat failing vacant will be allotted to other candidates from the waiting list.
- Special facilities for poor and deserving trainees will be made available to the extent possible.
- Rules of eligibility are followed strictly. The college however reserves the right to refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.
- A few seats are available "on payment seats".
- All students admitted to the college shall have to sign a form containing the code of conduct which will be furnished to them by the office.
 Violation in any manner beyond the code will justify their expulsion from the college.

In case of any dispute with the College/Management the District court at Darbhanga only shall have jurisdiction
